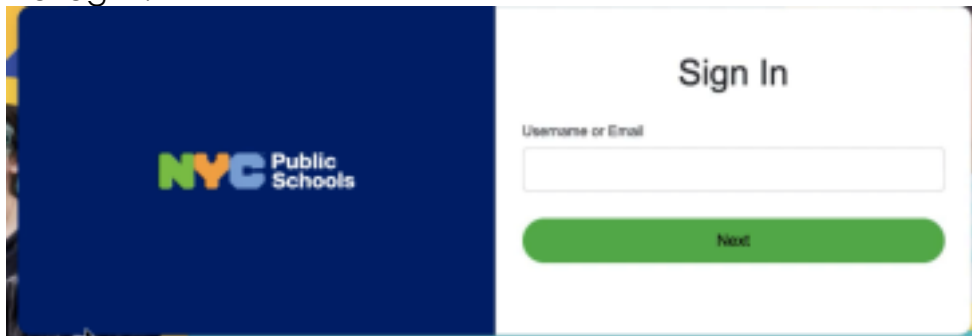

## INTO READING/INTO MATH – Understanding and Accessing ONLINE Student Scores

- All students in kindergarten through grade 5, take Into Reading assessments on the HMH platform. Our upper grades are also using this or in the process of transitioning to this for Into Math assessments as well. This is one measure of student understanding. We take into consideration when determining grades that taking tests on the computer is a relative new experience for some of our students. Teachers and students are utilizing this platform more as practice and for assessments. We also encourage you to practice typing and logging into Teachhub with your children at home.
- Paper-based assessments will be sent home once graded.

### INSTRUCTIONS

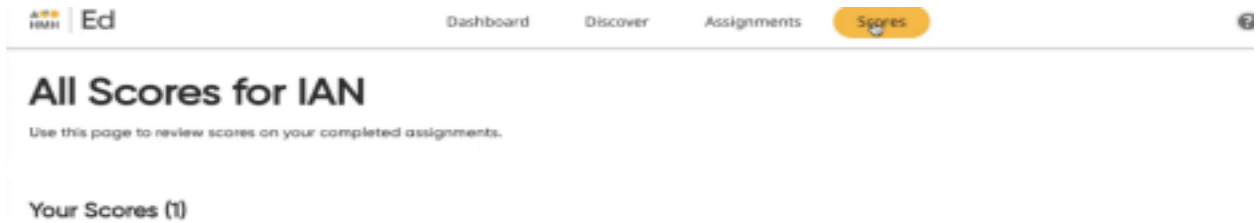
1. Go to our school website, <https://www.ps221q.org/>, or use a search engine to access TeachHub.
2. Use the username and password that your child uses to access Google Classroom to log in.



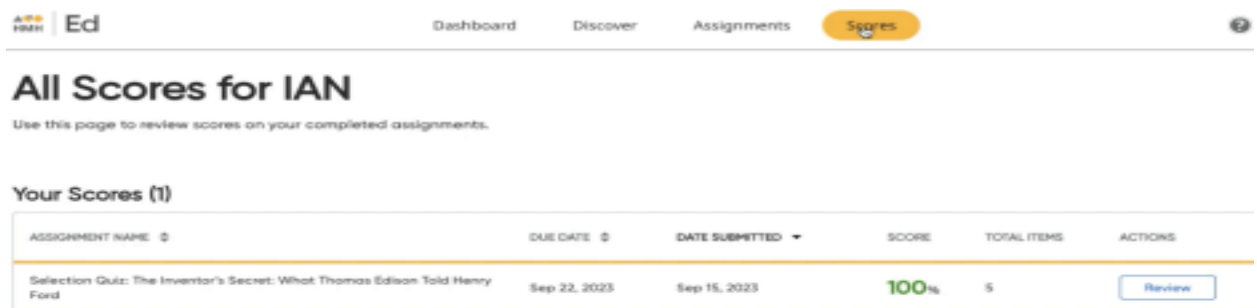
3. Scroll down until you see HMH Anywhere and click on it.



4. On the top, you will see a tab that says "Scores". Click on that.



5. Scroll down and you will see your child's score. You can also click on "Review" to see which items were incorrect.



### What do these scores mean?

1. The end of module assessment is used to measure student understanding of concepts taught throughout the module – this is one form of independent assessment and NOT the only score that goes into grades.
2. Scores are used to monitor progress and determine what concepts students may have mastered or need more support it.
3. Quizzes may also be used to measure understanding or used as a teaching tool to help students use this platform.
4. According to HMH scoring:
  - 80 – 100% is ABOVE grade level
  - 65 – 79% in ON grade level
  - 0 – 64% is BELOW grade level

### How can you help at home?

1. You can review material and help your children get a good nights sleep before an assessment.
2. Review student USERNAMES and PASSWORDS – practice typing them and having your child logon to TeachHub
3. Practice typing (programs can be found on our school website – go to your child's grade to find different programs they can use)
4. Reach out to your child's teacher with questions/concerns.
